Stakeholders

Are those who will be or are likely to be directly or indirectly affected, positively or negatively, by a project (commonly referred to as project-affected people or project-affected communities), as well as those who might have an interest in, or may influence, the project.

- Customers
- Villagers
- Village councils
- National and local authorities

Engage both affected communities and those with interests and influence!

Stakeholder Engagement (IFC PS1)

In Environmental and Social Management System

- Mitigate risk
- Manage expectations
- Establish support

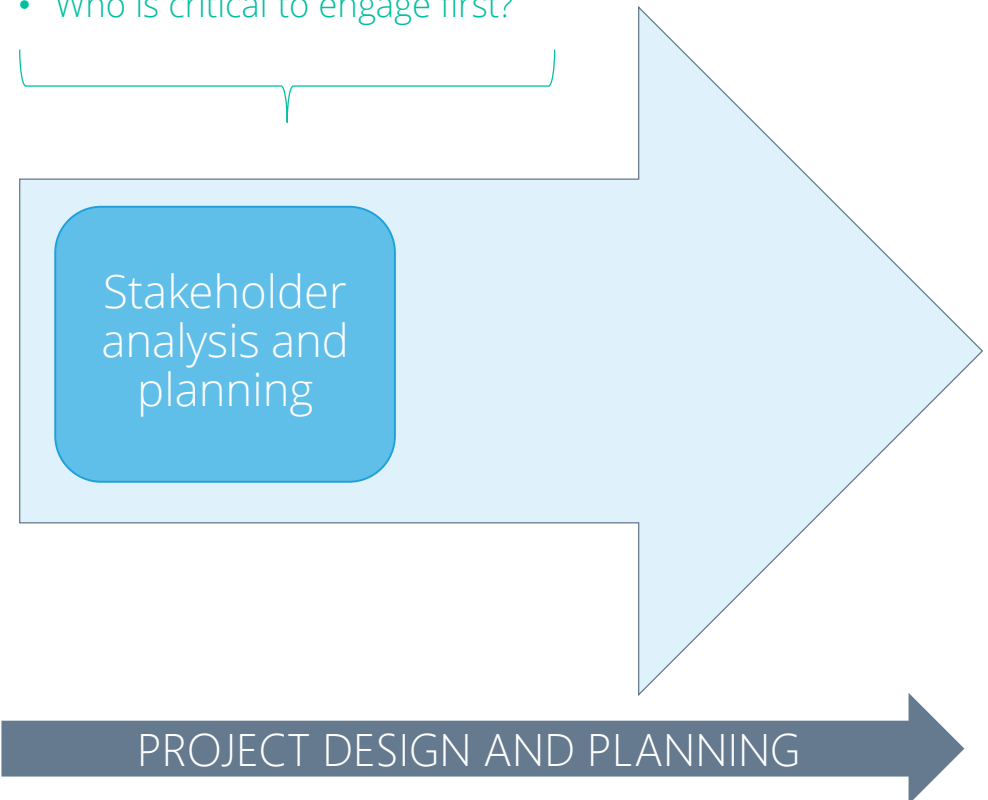
Get in early and be proactive! It is an engagement process (not consultation). Make long-term investments in relationship building and manage stakeholder engagement as a business function.

In Stakeholder Engagement

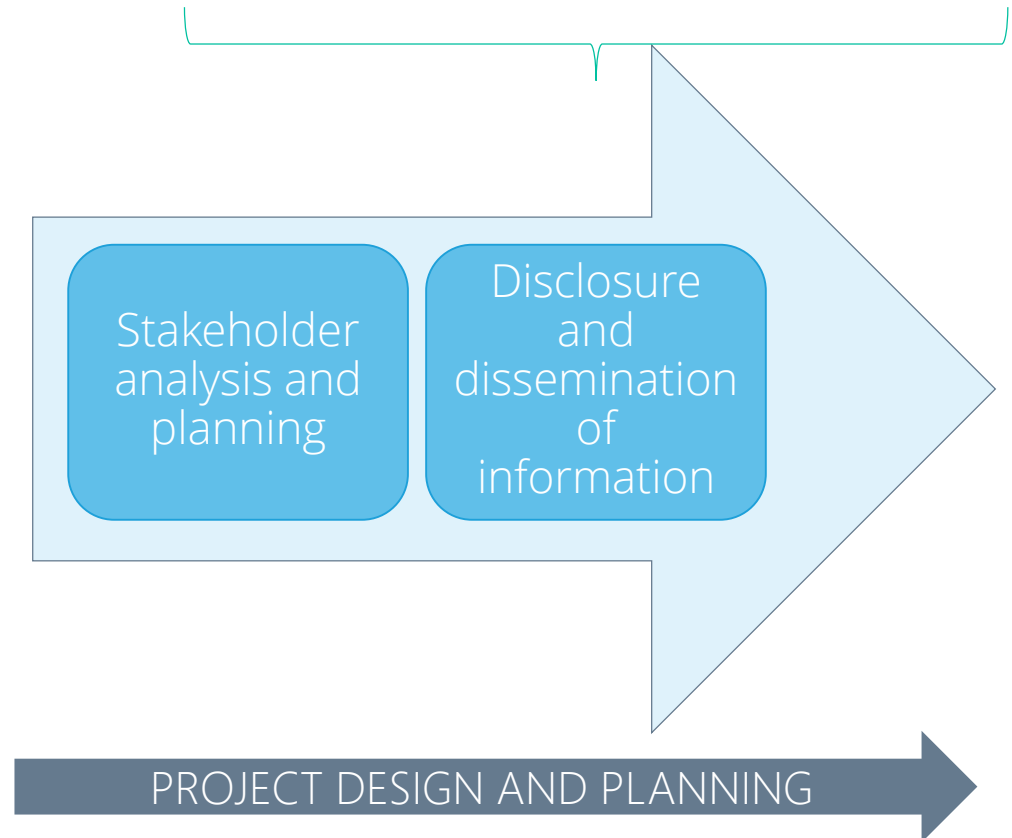
- Mandated by law or other requirements?
- Who will be adversely affected?
- Which stakeholders might help to enhance the project?
- Who would oppose and why?
- Who is critical to engage first?



Key Elements

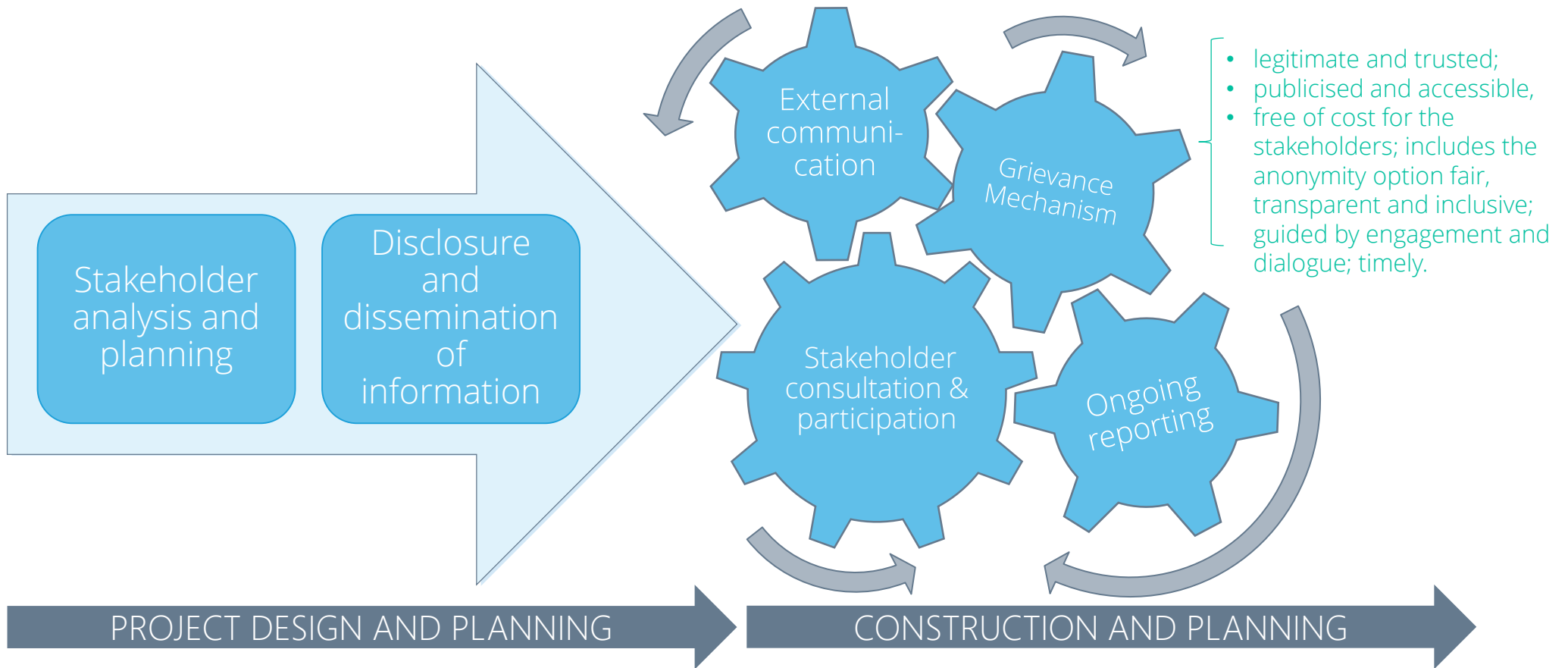
In Stakeholder Engagement

- Purpose and scale
- Duration
- Risk and impacts and relevant mitigation measures
- Envisaged stakeholder engagement process incl. grievance mechanism
