The following clarifications have been prepared to support REPP’s innovation request for proposals (RFP).

1.	What is REPP’s criteria for “innovative” in this RFP?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Technologies and business models that are first of their kind in the country or region; - Innovative business models and unique concepts supporting clean energy technologies; and/or - Innovative business models supporting the uptake of productive use of renewable energy.
2.	Is the 1MW minimum limit a strict limit?	Yes, although 1MW can be reached in aggregate (e.g. where the combined installed capacity of a project’s numerous mini-grids amounts to at least 1MW). Applicants need to provide a business plan that would lead to at least 1MW of installed power.
3.	How do I find out more about the eligibility criteria and other requirements for the RFP?	Please refer to the RFP itself for more information on the application, evaluation and selection processes. 4.	Which technology should we select if we are involved in solar pumping, captive PV, or PV and storage?	Please select the closest technology from the drop-down list in the eligibility form, then provide an explanation in the free-form text box explaining how the project fits the REPP criteria for the innovation RFP.
